

VideoRevealed Instagram Effects!

PLEASE READ ALL INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE POSTING QUESTIONS

NOTE: Textures are not supported in either .Look or .LUT formats so please don't ask why textures are missing.

Creative Cloud Subscribers

Import these Looks directly into your CC Library using this link:

Once you follow the online instructions, the .Look files will show up in a new Library called "Instagram Looks" in all your Libraries.

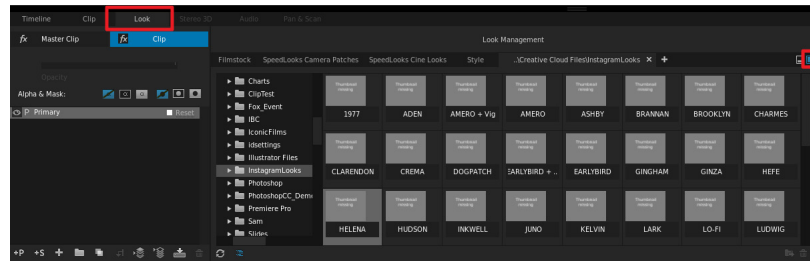
Premiere Pro CS6

These .Look files will not work with Premiere Pro CS6. And when I say "won't work", I mean please don't ask if they work, 'cause they won't.

When Adobe updates applications, they install new features. The new features will not work in older versions of applications. The only way to get all these great features is to become a Creative Cloud subscriber.

Now that you have the Instagram Looks installed in your CC Library, you can use them in the latest versions Premiere Pro CC, After Effects CC, Photoshop CC and SpeedGrade CC.

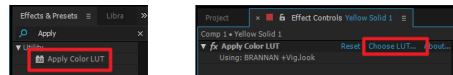
(SpeedGrade must manually locate the .Looks in the Look Management tab.)



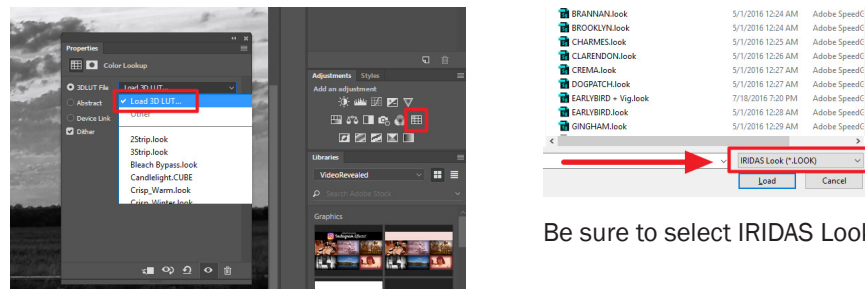
What about older versions of Photoshop and After Effects?

Earlier versions of Photoshop and After Effects can *most likely* use these Looks by loading them from within each program using the following effects:

After Effects - Apply Color LUT



Photoshop - Color Lookup Adjustment Layer



Making Looks available in the Lumetri Color Creative drop-down menu

It is possible to copy the Looks into the correct folder so they show up in the Creative drop-down menu.

NOTE: Adobe is changing the location of this folder in different versions and you are guaranteed to find inconsistencies when trying to access Looks placed in this folder. Currently, After Effects CC will not show the Instagram Looks in the drop-down menu but this may be fixed in a future version but right now it's busted.

Copy the .Look files to this location on Windows:

C:\Program Files\Adobe\Adobe Premiere Pro CC 2015.3\Lumetri\LUTs\Creative

Mac users may have to Control-click on the Premiere Pro icon in the Applications folder and choose "Show Package Contents" to see these folders.

Once again, Premiere Pro CS6 users, THIS WILL NOT WORK FOR YOUR VERSION!
